There was a strong connection between Armstrong Siddeley cars and the development of Canberra. William James (Jack) Mildenhall (1891-1962) became the Information Officer for the Federal Capital Commission in 1926, and subsequently created the Mildenhall collection of over 7,000 images of the development of Canberra now held by the National Archive of Australia ("NAA").
