



CLASSIC VEHICLE SCHEME (CVS) New Applications

To process your application:

You should fill in sections 1 and 2 of the Classic Vehicle Declaration (Transport NSW No. 1835).

Please do not fill in or sign section 3 of that form. This is for us to complete.

The primary club, i.e., your club, should stamp the lower right-side box to signify that you are a financial member of your club. Without that stamp, we cannot process the application.

The writing and stamps should be clearly written so they are legible.

What you need to send us:

The ORIGINAL Classic Vehicle Declaration Form (1835) completed and stamped by your club

A clear copy of your BLUE SLIP, (please remove the brake test before you make the copy).

A clear copy of your registration papers.

A clear copy of your engineer's certificate (if applicable)

Your contact phone number

Your contact email address.

A printout or email of your payment receipt or a cheque, a money order, or cash for \$30

An express post envelope if you need it returned quickly. (Optional)

The processing is done at Seven Hills.

Maggie and Rachael are your "responsible persons" and will be available on the phone for enquiries or in person to process your paperwork.

The processing fee is \$30, which includes return postage with tracking.

Please identify the payment in the reference field with a surname, initials and club or Association name/number.

E.g. Jones JR Moonshine or Jones JR ANSMA 1256

DO NOT use your vehicle to identify your payment, it is not unique and could be applied to the incorrect documents. This causes confusion and delays.

We accept: Cheque, Money order, Cash or Direct Credit. **We prefer:** Direct Credit or Cash.

Banks charge a fee to cash cheques and money orders so we would prefer you to use direct credit or cash if possible.

When you attend Service NSW, you must insist on them looking at the CLASSIC Vehicle Scheme. If they incorrectly look at the Historic Vehicle Scheme, they will not be able to process your application.

The number plates you should receive, will have NSW-Conditional written across the bottom, if they don't, they are the wrong plates. Motorcycles will receive smaller plates with four numbers and a letter.
