President chaired the meeting, which opened at 7:36 pm.

Minutes of previous General Meeting:

Minutes of the September '25 General Meeting: Moved: Tony Von Brandenstein; Seconded: Fred Zarb; Carried.

Business arising: Eligibility for membership in CRS moved to general business.

President:

- Still waiting for The Secretary to get a Quote from Thoroughbred Park regarding use of that facility for Wheels 2026. Believes there is an issue with Wheels being sponsored by Famous Insurance Brokers and Thoroughbred Park having their own insurance.
- The President attended a meeting at Thoroughbred Park regarding Festival of Speed and suggested that it would be nice to have some Australian race cars, he felt they heard him but are more interested in Lamborghinis and Ferraris.

Vice President:

- Asks if clubs can let the council know of any events they are organising or have heard about so council can be kept up to date of events. Otherwise we cannot put the details on the website

Treasurer:

- The council has \$61,529.13 in account.
- After talking to other banks Council is staying with Westpac but has checked the new account is set up with two factor authentication and tested it with a \$20 payment.
- The Pie Cart is still undergoing mechanical rectification to enable full registration as a condition of sale. The Secretary is progressing this work in order for transfer to the buyer (Mecure Canberra Hotel). The buyer is keen to receive the cart. The repairs are estimated to cost the council about \$20,000.
- A question from a Delegate related to CACTMC operating surplus/loss and retained funds. Post meeting the Treasurer provided the following on CACTMC recent operating costs (excludes retained funds including sale of the Pie Cart and investment account). The audited CACTMC Financial Report is provided at the AGM.

Secretary:

- Not Present

Events:

- **Sunday 19th Oct 25:** Tarago Car Show.
- **Sunday 26th Oct 25:** Canberra Swap Meet at Hall Showgrounds
- **Saturday 1st Nov 25: French Car show.** Transferred from Telopea park school to the Spanish Club. Date has t changed.
- **Sunday 2 Nov 25: Terribly British Day.** Currently planned for Queanbeyan Park.
- **Saturday 6th Dec 25:** 100 Years of Ford. The PFV (Ford Performance Vehicles) Club has cancelled the planned event for 100 years of Ford. The Ford GT club has organised with Ollies to hold the event as an Ollies open day plus cars in the parking area outside.
- The CACTMC is still awaiting a cost proposal from Thoroughbred Park regarding use of that facility for a large car display. The location for Wheels 2026 will be advised at the November CACTMC general monthly meeting.

Registrar:

- The Licensing and Registration Administration (LARA) website sometimes allows on line renewal of CRS registration without uploading Certificate of Inspection Forms. If this happens to you just send the Certificate of Inspection to the LARA address. You can also renew in person at the shopfront or by post.
- Dave advised that a member of an affiliate club has not used their vehicle in conjunction with the rules. It involved usage in excess of the 60 days and non-compliance with logbook requirements. Dave will forward all the information collated to the RTA with a recommendation from the Committee that some form of penalty be imposed.
- The MOU between the ACT Government and the CACTMC is being updated to align the new titles of relevant Government agencies. Main points are;
 - CRS now stands for Conditional Registration System instead of Concessional.
 - Currently allows similar engines to be fitted for restorations where original is no longer available (e.g. Morris Minors can have a Toyota engine of same power and size fitted) as long as there is no power augmentation, i.e. turbo. Updates to MOU will include a generic provision for another engine where a manufacturer offered optional engines for the same body in a production run.
 - MOU to list fines as dot points
 - CTP to be renamed MAI (Major Accident Insurance) to align with NSW.
- All other aspects and operation of the system remain unchanged.
- The Registrar will update the By Laws to incorporate changes in the MOU.
- The club Nobodies have been granted access to CRS.
- Message for Registrars/ Compliance Inspectors;
 - When completing registration renewal check, ensure the log book for;
 - Car Odometer reading equates to logbook entries (approximate).
 - Page 5 Club membership is completed and signed by club official.

Wheels:

- **No quote yet from Thoroughbred Park. Site and insurance.**

Terribly British Day

- **2nd November. 50th anniversary**

General Business:

- Can the committee look at the costs for clubs based on number of members, the smaller clubs feel they are paying a lot more per member than the larger clubs.
- If the Council has sufficient funds in the bank why does it need to charge clubs at all. Treasurer replied that the council does not plan to make a profit and the funds will drop significantly once the Pie cart repairs are paid for. In the 4/5 years he has been the treasurer the funds have been flat lined with the fees roughly equalling the expenditure, with Insurance for Events going up the overall fees collected can't really be reduced.

- It was suggested that the council looks at car councils in other states to see what they charge to see if it is reasonable.
- The President advised the Committee will examine the matter of annual fees and report back to the Council.
- HSV club was looking at running a car show near Questacon. Costs included \$2000 venue hire and each car needs a drip tray even though it is a public carpark plus about \$7,000 for Traffic management. Council agrees the Government is too expensive and too hard to deal with and even Queanbeyan costs have been going up.
- Venues suggested for running a car show included Hall Showgrounds, Deakin Football Club, Tuggeranong Homestead and the Spanish Club. These seem to be able to cover the expensive Public Liability Insurance with no cost to the car clubs.
- Workers Comp issues at Thoroughbred Park means trainers have moved to Queanbeyan or Bungendore. This might be sorted out and Thoroughbred Park could still be interested in car shows. The Secretary will examine the issue with Thoroughbred Park.
